



NOISE POLICY

Comgroup Supplies Pty Ltd will follow the *Environmental Protection (Noise) Policy 2019*; the *Environmental Protection Regulation 2019* and the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* to uphold a safe working environment for all workers and members of the public. We also will do our best as practicably possible to the control and minimise the noise impact in the acoustic environment surrounding each facility.


At Comgroup Supplies, we do this by:

- Identifying where noise emissions may occur and exceed the acceptable standards to protect environmental values
- Where workers or members of the general public are exposed to plant and machinery with noise emissions exceeding acceptable standards, we will take measures to minimise exposure
- Providing adequate hearing protection (PPE) to all personnel where there is a risk of noise to exceed the acceptable standards
- Ensuring signs and notifications are posted in areas where hearing protection is required as stated in relevant legislature
- Consulting; educating and training workers and members of the public in the use and maintenance of PPE
- Continually monitoring and reviewing plant, machinery and person noise exposures in the workplace on a regular basis and communicate noise survey results to all workers
- Conducting audio metric assessments within the first 3 months of employment, with follow up assessments every 2 years and when an employee ceases employment
- Regularly monitor and survey noise impacts from its operations on external stakeholders
